

DISPOSING OF BULK ITEMS

The following is a list of procedures our company has developed as a guide for our customers to use so we can work together to ensure safe and efficient disposal of trash.

Carpeting: We will take up to four rolls per week of carpeting free of charge. Carpeting needs to be cut into lengths no longer than three feet, rolled up and tied in bundles that one person can pick up.

Paint: At this time we are not able to dispose of liquid paint. We will take paint cans as long as the content is completely dry. Latex paint can be dried out by putting kitty litter in the can. Paint cans need to be set next to your regular trash with the lids off.

Oil: Oil has been banned from Illinois landfills. As a result, we are not able to dispose of oil for our customers. Many local service stations and area car care clinics will recycle motor oil. There may be a charge.

Pool liners: Pool liners must be cut and rolled, each roll weighing no more than 50 pounds.

Appliances: We will take one large household item per week. Appliances must be at the curb on your regular day. By law, all refrigerator doors must be completely taken off.

Construction Debris: We will take two cans of construction debris per week as long as they weigh no more than 50 pounds each.

WELCOME

Thank you for choosing Nuway/ Tinley Park Disposal to provide for your disposal needs. The following information will help you with your new service.

- Pickup times may be early in the morning. All garbage must be at the curb by 6:30am on your pickup day. Putting your garbage out the night before would help avoid missing your pickup.
- Bills for your household service are issued on a quarterly basis: January, April, July, and October.
- Once a week, at no extra charge, we will gladly pick up one large item placed at the curb by 6:30am on your normal pickup day.
- Additional pick ups are available for an extra cost. Please phone the office at least 24 hours prior to additional pickup.
- Yard waste is picked up April 1st – November 30th. Please see yard waste section for removal options.
- Recyclables will be picked up **EVERY OTHER WEEK**. A calendar with your pickup days is included in this packet.

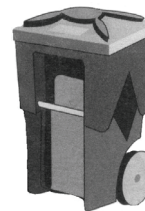
CURRENT DISPOSAL SERVICES

Household Garbage

Household garbage will be picked up every week. Each home in the Village has received a 95-gallon brown garbage cart. If you would like an additional garbage cart, they are available to rent for \$2.75/month (added to your quarterly bill). You may choose to use your own garbage cans for extra garbage (up to three per week). You can do so as long as each can holds no more than 35 gallons.

Recycling

Recycle carts have been provided. Recycling will be picked up **EVERY OTHER WEEK** on your normal pick up day. Please refer to the calendar for your recycle pickup days. A list of acceptable recyclables has also been provided.



Yard Waste

Yard waste season is April 1st through November 30th. You can put your yard waste out on your normal pickup day.

Yard waste cannot be combined with other garbage. Containers/bags with yard waste and garbage mixed will be left at the curb.

Yard waste will only be collected in the village approved green cart or yard waste bags.

One option is to place all yard waste material in a 30 gallon brown paper yard waste bag. Another option for yard waste would be to purchase or rent a 96 gallon yard waste cart. If you would like to use the yard waste cart, please complete and return the enclosed form.

Branches: When putting branches out for pick up, they should be cut in 3-4' lengths, no wider than 6" in diameter, and placed into brown paper yard waste bags or tied into reasonable sized bundles.
