PACE Bus Service for Tinley Park Seniors and the handicapped is available Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., excluding holidays. Reservations should be made 24 hours in advance by calling:

Arrangements for transportation to and from medical or other doctor appointments should be made two (2) days in advance.

Fares: Fare per ride is \$0.65 with an RTA reduced fare card for age 65 and older or \$1.30 per ride without the card. Fare for ages 55 to 64 is \$1.30 per ride.

Please note: Village bus service for medical appointments in Orland Park, Mokena and Oak Forest is only available 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Reservations must be made 48 hours in advance. Fare is \$0.75 each way for seniors 65 years and older and \$1.50 for 55 to 64 years old.
