

# **CHAPTER IX - MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC STREETS AND RIGHT-OF-WAYS**

## **SECTION 900 – CLEANING OF STREETS**

### **A. General**

The current adopted ordinance of the Village of Tinley Park Prohibiting Spilling or Dropping Materials or Littering the Streets, Alleys and Sidewalks and Providing Penalties Therefore in The Village of Tinley Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois is hereby incorporated into this Building Code, and is as effective and binding as if fully set forth herein.

## **SECTION 901 – STREET & ALLEY LITTERING**

All streets and alleys adjoining the construction site shall be kept clean and free of all mud, waste, and debris caused by construction operations. Such materials shall be removed from the Public Way immediately.

## **SECTION 902 - RESPONSIBILITY**

The Permittee to whom a building permit has been issued shall be responsible for policing all streets adjoining the site of his operations and he shall be liable for any fines or penalties relating to Sections 900, 901, 903 and 904.

## **SECTION 903 – SPOIL PILES, EXCESS EARTH, BUILDING MATERIALS, ETC.**

Streets and public ways shall not be used for storage of these materials and they shall be deposited away from the right-of-way a sufficient distance to prevent sliding, spilling, or washing onto public property.

## **SECTION 904 – DUMPSTERS, CONTAINERS FOR DEBRIS, ETC.**

No dumpsters, or other containers for debris, shall be placed on, or shall project into, any improved street or public right-of-way.
