
The President of the Police Pension Board finds that an in person meeting is not practical or prudent and that in person attendance by one of the Pension Board Trustees at the Police Department is not feasible due the coronavirus and the Governor's Disaster Proclamation.

The public hearing will be held to receive evidence concerning the amount of Applicant's "Final Salary" for Pension purposes. The Applicant is entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to present any evidence and to respond to any evidence before the Board.

The public hearing is being held via videoconference without the requirement of in-person attendance in accordance with Governor Pritzker's Executive Order. The public will be given the opportunity to participate by calling in at (312) 626-6799 or logging in at zoom.us. The meeting ID is 937 0621 0855 and the password is 135050. Public comment will be held during the meeting and will be limited to 5 minutes per person.

The Pension Board may adjourn to Executive or Closed Session, pursuant to §2(c)(4) of the Open Meetings Act, for purposes of deliberations, upon completion of the evidentiary hearing. No final action will be taken in Executive/Closed Session.
