Thursday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 – 6:00 p.m.

A regular meeting of the Tinley Park Police Pension Board was called to order at 6:11 p.m. by President Violetto. The following were:

PRESENT: President Violetto, Trustee Carl Lindokken, Trustee Timothy Ehlers, and Trustee Frederick Mondt. (One appointed trustee spot vacant)

See attachment for hearing on the retirement application of Deputy Chief Charles Faricelli.

President Violetto asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting held on 05/18/2020. Trustee Lindokken moved and Trustee Mondt seconded the motion. The minutes were reviewed by board members. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote. President Violetto declared the motion carries.

John Falduto presented the financial report of the fund for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2020. The account began the quarter with a market value of \$67,357,688. (\$66,873,485 when adjusted for contributions, distributions, and expenses) The account ended the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter with a market value of \$75,661,955. The investment return for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter was \$8,788,470. The account had a gross return of 13.09% and a net return of 13.04% for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.

President Violetto asked for a motion to approve the financial report. Trustee Mondt moved and Trustee Lindokken seconded the motion.

A roll call vote was conducted.

AYES: President Violetto, Trustee Lindokken, Trustee Ehlers, and Trustee Mondt

NAYES: None

Allison Barrett of Lauterbach and Amen presented the vendor check report for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2020. President Violetto asked for a motion to approve the vendor check report. Trustee Ehlers moved and Trustee Lindokken seconded the motion.

A roll call vote was conducted.

AYES: President Violetto, Trustee Lindokken, Trustee Ehlers, and Trustee Mondt

NAYES: None

President Violetto asked for a motion to approve a pension for Detective John Bonarek. Trustee Mondt moved and Trustee Ehlers seconded the motion. President Violetto stated that Detective John Bonarek had a service start date of 06/21/1991 and a retirement date of 07/06/2020. Detective Bonarek is a Tier 1 officer. Detective Bonarek has 29 years of service and he will receive 72.50% of his final pensionable salary of \$110,758.56. Detective Bonarek will receive an initial monthly benefit of \$6691.66 in the interim, pending approval of a new collective bargaining agreement.

A roll call vote was conducted.

AYES: President Violetto, Trustee Lindokken, Trustee Ehlers, and Trustee Mondt

NAYES: None

President Violetto asked for a motion to approve a pension for Commander Anthony Campbell. Trustee Mondt moved and Trustee Lindokken seconded the motion. President Violetto stated that Commander Campbell has a service start date of 05/09/1992 and a retirement date of 07/11/2020. Commander Campbell is a Tier 1 officer. Commander Campbell has 28 years of service and he will receive 70% of his final pensionable salary of \$144,403.03. Commander Campbell will receive an initial benefit of \$8423.51 monthly.

President Violetto asked for a motion to appoint the following officer positions: Trustee Violetto as President, Trustee Lindokken as Vice President, Trustee Mondt as Secretary, and Trustee Ehlers as assistance secretary. Trustee Ehlers moved and Trustee Lindokken seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously by voice vote.

President Violetto asked for a motion to approve payment of the quarterly retainer fee of \$750 to Reimer & Dobrovolny for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2020. Trustee Lindokken moved and Trustee Ehlers seconded the motion.

A roll call vote was conducted.

AYES: President Violetto, Trustee Lindokken, Trustee Ehlers, and Trustee Mondt

NAYES: None

There was no member of the public wishing to comment.

President Violetto asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:37P.M. Trustee Lindokken moved and Trustee Ehlers seconded the motion.

The motion carried unanimously by voice vote. President Violetto declared the motion carries.

1           PRESIDENT VIOLETTO: All right. We'll call the  
2 meeting to order at 6:11.

3                     The first item on the agenda, we'll move  
4 it to the hearing on the motion to award interim  
5 retirement benefits to Deputy Chief Charles Faricelli  
6 without prejudice, subject to verification of final  
7 salary.

8           MR. REIMER: Thank you. Do you want me to make a  
9 record for you?

10           PRESIDENT VIOLETTO: Sure.

11           MR. REIMER: All right. So the record should  
12 reflect that upon learning there was a potential  
13 dispute over Deputy Chief Faricelli's final salary to  
14 be used for pension purposes, I advised the Board that  
15 it should consider paying the Deputy Chief on the  
16 non-contested amount without prejudice on an interim  
17 basis while the Board obtains the necessary records  
18 from the Village to ascertain what the actual salary  
19 is. So I did send Deputy Chief Faricelli a letter  
20 dated July 15th, 2020 advising him of what I had  
21 suggested.

22                     Deputy Chief, you are here. We appreciate

1 it. I don't know if there's anything you want to add,  
2 but if you are not -- if you have no objection, what I  
3 would just ask the Board to do is entertain a motion to  
4 award you those benefits without prejudice on an  
5 interim basis. That way, they can pay you right away,  
6 and then as soon as we get a response to the subpoena  
7 that I have prepared today, we'll get those documents  
8 and we'll come back. And then we'll be able to figure  
9 out what the appropriate salary is.

10 Are you in agreement with that?

11 MR. FARICELLI: Yes.

12 MR. REIMER: Thank you, sir.

13 So my suggestion, Mr. President, is the  
14 Board entertain a motion to pay Deputy Chief Faricelli  
15 a retirement pension without prejudice on an interim  
16 basis based upon an ending salary of \$155,204.30.

17 He's entitled to 52.5 percent of that  
18 originally granted monthly pension amount of \$6,790.19,  
19 and that would be effective July 10th, 2020. Again, I  
20 just want to reiterate that's on an interim basis  
21 without prejudice or waiver to determining a higher  
22 salary.
