Bremen Township to host tax appeal seminar

September 1, 2016, Tinley Park, Illinois -- The Cook County Board of Review Commissioner Dan Patlak will be holding a property tax appeal seminar at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 7, 2016 at the Tinley Park Village Hall, 16250 S. Oak Park Avenue, for taxpayers seeking to appeal their 2016 property tax assessments. Bremen Township is open for appeal at the Board of Review August 22 – September 20, 2016.

The seminar is co-sponsored by Bremen Township Assessor Willie Jones, Tinley Park Mayor David Seaman and Tinley Park Trustee Kevin Suggs. The hour long session will educate taxpayers on how to file a successful tax appeal, provide information on property tax exemptions, and address why property taxes go up when the value of your home goes down.

The seminar includes a presentation by Commissioner Dan Patlak explaining the appeal procedure at the Board of Review. Before the end of the evening, taxpayers will have an opportunity to work with staff from the Board of Review to address their specific questions and concerns.

This event is free to the public, and there is no fee to appeal at the Board of Review. Taxpayers are asked to bring a copy of their most recent tax bill.
