Charges filed in Tinley Park shooting

A Tinley Park man has been charged with one count of attempted murder after he shot a man seven times with a handgun following a traffic incident July 18 in the 6900 block of 173rd Place.

According to the Tinley Park Police Department, Andres Rodriguez, 38, 18212 Kirby Drive, was walking near 69th Avenue and 173rd Place at around 1:30 a.m. when he ran into a vehicle driven by a 25-year-old man.

The driver exited his vehicle to check on Rodriguez, and a scuffle ensued, resulting in Rodriguez shooting the driver seven times with a handgun. Rodriguez was immediately taken into custody by responding officers. The driver was able to talk to investigators but remains hospitalized, police said.

Rodriguez was transported to Bridgeview Courthouse for a bond hearing this morning.
