Lane Bryant Homicide Investigation  
June 10, 2008

The Tinley Park Police Department and the South Suburban Major Crimes Task Force are making available to the public a “3-dimensional” computer generated composite likeness of the offender in this investigation (see attached). The computer generated likeness was developed by the Illinois State Police working closely with the surviving victim of the crime.

The description of the physical characteristics of the offender has not changed, however the new composite reveals a more life-like depiction of the killer. In addition to the attached composite to the media, the Tinley Park Police Department website ([www.tinleyparkpolice.org](http://www.tinleyparkpolice.org)) will also display the likeness for public access.

The public is reminded that the killer remains at large, and should be considered armed and dangerous. A one hundred thousand dollar reward has been established for information leading to the arrest of the killer. The reward is NOT dependant upon conviction. Any information can be kept confidential.
