

## Construction Notice

### Creek Stabilization and Sanitary Sewer Manhole Maintenance

The Village of Tinley Park recently contracted an outside entity to clean and inspect the Village's sanitary sewer and manholes along Ridgeland Avenue between 167<sup>th</sup> Street and 175<sup>th</sup> Street. During the inspection, it was observed that one of the sanitary sewer manholes located near Midlothian Creek, off Forest Glen Drive, has been exposed due to erosion issues along the bank of the creek (see below). At this location, there exists a siphon system that conveys wastewater under the creek.



It has been determined that the bank of the creek needs to be stabilized to prevent any further erosion as well as further maintenance to the sanitary sewer structures (2) that accommodate the wastewater system. This will be done by installing large diameter riprap around the structure to restore the stability of the bank around the structures, shore up the bank around the siphon pipe, and prevent any further erosion of the creek bank. The siphon system will then undergo a full inspection.

The work is scheduled to begin mid-May and conclude late-June 2018 (weather permitting). The Village has coordinated this work with the Park District and area residents. The Village of Tinley Park appreciates your understanding and will continue to provide updates to the residents as information becomes available.
