The Emergency Management & 911 Communications Center is proud to announce the implementation of a program designed to assist you and/or your loved ones in the event of an emergency. On August 28, 2009 Senate Bill 2057 – Premise Alert Program – was signed into law and passed in the General Assembly with unanimous, bipartisan support. The Illinois Premise Alert Program (PAP) allows individuals with disabilities or special needs, their families or care givers to register with Police, Fire and/or Ambulance agencies. The information provided will supply these agencies with potentially life-saving information about their conditions if called upon to provide emergency service.

In accordance with this law, The Emergency Management and 911 Communications Center, would like to take this opportunity to invite you to participate in this voluntary program. By completing the attached form, we will be able to 'flag' your residence with the particular special needs of you or your family member which will enable the dispatcher to quickly inform the Public Safety Personnel of important medical information.
