



2019 Music in the Plaza Food and Beverage Vendor Opportunities

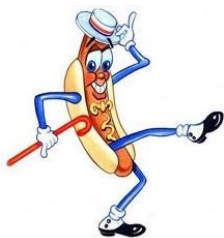
Applications are now available for Tinley Park businesses interested in becoming a food and beverage vendor for the Music in the Plaza Concert Series. The concerts draw between 3,000 to 5,000 per night and are free to attend, family friendly, and highly popular. Bands will include a variety of music from classic rock to boy bands.

Potential vendors are being offered a combined food and beverage option. Selected vendors must have a Tinley Park liquor license or partner with another Tinley Park business that possesses one. A special event liquor license will also be required from both the Village and the State. Each vendor must supply a kid-friendly food item on the menu. New this year, an opportunity is available to Food and Beverage Vendors to also sell snacks like popcorn, cotton candy, and snow cones. Interested businesses will receive a larger space and must commit to providing additional staff to serve the increased number of customers.

Vendor's vehicles will only be allowed inside the event perimeter until 6:15 p.m. at which point all equipment and deliveries must be hand delivered. Vendors are supplied with a designated space and electricity and are responsible for their own set-up including tables and lights. A pop-up tent and visible signage identifying the vendor are also required. Vendors must be operational by 6:45 p.m.

The Food and Beverage vendor fee is \$250 per concert. Only one Food and Beverage Vendor and one Snack Vendor will be approved for each concert. Concerts will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, taking into account the preferred date. If there is still an open date by May 13, an interested vendor may be approved for a second date.

If you are interested in becoming a vendor, please complete the included Vendor Agreement. Payment will be requested once your date has been confirmed and must be received before June 3rd. In the event that a concert is canceled before 6 p.m., the vendor fee will be refunded.

Vendors must obtain a one-day liquor license from the Village and the State. Restaurants without a liquor license may make arrangements to partner with a bar or restaurant that has one. Only one Food and Beverage Vendor and one Snack Vendor will be accepted for each concert. Vendors also interested in selling snacks must mark the checkbox below and include proposed snacks.
